Bear Mr. Carpenter: -

In answer to your communication of the 21st regarding the "Lovelock Nickel Mine" would state that the legal owner of this property, is Miss Ruth Ruddell of Lovelock, Nevada.

This property, has had considerable development work and in the early eighties, a small waterjacket furnace was operated for the reduction of the ores to matte. Shortly after a brief runa clogging of the waterjacket developed and the furnace blew up. The operator in charge was seriously injured ultimately loosing his eyesight.

Most of the earlier production on ore was "sorted" and shipped vie San Francisco to Swansea in England. On account of the long period of (ime ('sailing by Cape Horn) before returns came in, it was decided to install the smelting furnace above mevtioned.

The ores of this property, contained considerable amounts of Cobalt. Thas was not recovered, but passed up the furnace stack and deposited over considerable area of the ajacent rocks in the form of "cobalt blue"

The total period of operation occupied about five years.

I am giving here a brief resume of this property. The geology has been comprehensively treated in a bulletin issued by the mining department of the University of Nevada, several years

This brocure was quiet comptete both in geology and mineralogj of all that Morthern part of Churchill County,

The other Nickel Mine mentioned in this report, is the "Bell Nickel Mine." This property is owned by Tasker L. Oddie X-Govenor of the State. I am sure it would be his pleasure to answer any communication you send him.
