High Jinks Tungsten Prospect

T10N, R22E, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  mi. SW of Wellington,  
Nevada, Wellington District, owner - H.  
E. Fulstone. Scheelite thought to occur  
in joints of veins in andesite porphyry.  
U.S.B.M. - 1 trench and 2 shafts, 30 and  
80 feet deep - originally gold prospect.  
Tungsten.

Lindsay and Barry Prospect

T9N, R33E, 30 mi. S of Minden, Nevada,  
near Mountain House District. Ls cut  
by igneous dike 50-70 ft. wide - Rhyolite  
stock nearby. U.S.B.M. 2 inclined shafts  
60 ft. apart  $\pm$  40 ft. deep. Lead - Zinc.

Blue Metals Mine

Sec.14, T.12N., R.23E, MDBM. James S. Adams &  
Alex Castaing, Yerington, Nev.; Judge Clark J.  
Guild, Carson City. Originally was gold prospect.  
Corundum-Andalusite
