Elko is the county seat, and is pleasantly situated on the north side of the Humboldt River. ... The railroad company haver here large storehouses, from which are forwarded goods to most of the mining districts in the northern and southern parts of the State. ...

Carlin, Toano, Humboldt Wells, and Palisades are also towns situated on the railroad in this county. At Carlin, the railroad has its machine shops for the Humboldt Division of the road. Toano is the point from which freight is forwarded to Pioche; and from Humboldt Wells there is a stage line to Sprucement and Shellburn. From this point machinery and all kinds of freight are shipped to these districts. From Palisades a daily line of stages runs to Mineral Hill, Eureka, Hamilton, and Pioche. Pritchard's fast freight line also stafts from this point on the ra; lroad going through to Pioche.
