On May 9, 1940, Taylor and Evans revisited the Sorensen tungsten claims near Cucomungo Springs (just out of Lida and Goldfield). The contact between limestone and intrusive was reexamined for a distance of about 2000 feet. No new develop ments were encountered and additional material when examined under the ultra violet lamp, indicated that the 0.67 tungsten trioxide sample, mentioned in an earlier report is the an exception and not the average. The property can well be forgotten.
