Antimony King Mine

T 46N, R45W, Sec. 30, 24½ mi. SE Battle Mountain, (Chris J. Nelson, 346 Warren Street, Monmouth, Oregon). Antimony, report, September 1943, also U.S.G.S. report.

Old Lead Zinc Mine (Nevada Mining Company Mine)

Battle Mountain District, 13½ mi. SW from Battle Mountain, Lead - Zinc. Report December 1942.

Midland and Northland Claims
(formerly Buckingham Ms.Co.)

Battle Mountain Range, Battle Mountain District, 10 mi. S Battle Mountain. (S. F. O'Leary - owner) Tunnel, next sh. 85' several irregular & cuts and drifts. Water to 18' below collar. Lead-Zinc-Copper.

Big Creek Antimony Mine

Big Creek District in Big Creek Canyon. Sec. 27, T17N, R43E, 17 mi. S Austin. (Tony Romano, owner, 2500 Canyon Drive, Hollywood, California) Two main tunnels and several short tunnels w/open cuts. Upper tunnel #2, 360'; Lower #1 caved, inaccessible. Two X cut tunnels w/short drifts and x cuts on Hard Luck claim. Antimony.

Armor Mine (formerly Trinity Mine)

Battle Mountain District, 15 mi. S Battle Mountain. (Symanzik and Wrokel, leasers; J. A. Langwith and Associates, owners) Adit, old incl, shaft, open to adit level; sloped areas from adit level to surface. Ref. to U.S.G.S. Bull. 594 - 1915, pp. 85-87. Silver, Lead, Zinc.

O'Leary Property (24 claims)

S30, T32N, R44E, 9.4 mi. SW by road from Battle Mountain, Battle Mountain District, owner - Stanley F. O'Leary, Battle Mountain. Igneous intrusions cut quartzite, gabbro dike and quartz porphyry ore vein stk. N50° to 150°E. Small irregular ore shoots. U.S.B.M. (Shaft 850 ft. deep w/ 2,700 ft. drifts and X cut.) Lead, Zinc, Silver.

Hard Luck Tungsten

T17N, R43E, 19 mi. S Austin, Nevada, Big Creek District, owner - Tony Romano, Austin Deposit - silicified fault breccia cemented by white quartz intergrown with stibnite. U.S.B.M. 7 adits from 80-300 ft. in length. Antimony.

Burridge Antimony

S31, T32N, R44E. Deposit in quartz in quartzite. U.S.B.M. Few Trenches. Antimony.

Goldacres Mine

T27 and 28N, R46 and 47E, Bullion District, operator - Harry W. Treweck, Beowawe. Developed 50,000 tons gold ore during 1934-1941. Carboniferous sediments - intruded by porphyry shows tactite area of with small amount of scheelite. U.S.B.M. Developed mine - shut down in 1942 (WFB-L-208) Tungsten.

Black Rock

±19 mi. SW of Valmy, Battle Mountain District. Core drilled by Bureau - 39,000 ton of 16.5 per cent ore. Manganese oxides outcrop along considerable area. U.S.B.M. 1940-41 - Numerous trenches - pits and drill holes. Manganese.

Mendive Group and Billy Day Claim

T23(32)N, R44E, M.D.M and B, 6 mi. SW of Battle Mountain, (B. S. Mendive, Box K, Battle Mountain). Silver, Copper, February, 1943.

O'Leary Mine (Old Buckingham Mines Company, Prop)

Battle Mountain Range, 10 mi. S Battle Mountain, Zinc - Silver - Lead. April 1943.

Armor Claim

Battle Mountain District, (Symanzir and Wrobel, Lessors, (See R.F.C. File "A" La-3) May 1943. Silver - Lead.
