

Project Description: Santa Fe Pacific Gold Corporation has begun to develop a new open-pit mine in the North Shoshone Range, involving 2,878 acres of public and private land.

Major Issues: Native American concerns; sulfide ore handling; transportation of ore.

Interested Publics: Lander County, Western Shoshone, residents along ore haulage routes.

Schedule: The Record of Decision and Plan of Operations Approval for this project was signed and distributed to the public on October 28, 1996. Two appeals were filed with Interior Board of Land Appeals by the Northern Nevada Building Trades Council and by a local resident.
