Location of Claims:


The claims are located about 3 miles Westerly of the Dahl Placer and in the general area of the Duval operations. The claims are in Section 30, T31N; R42E. This is about 6 miles North of the North end of the McCoy or Group 32 claims owned by Hughes Tool Company.

History: These claims are undeveloped. They are in a similar formation as that being worked by Duval. They show some values in gold and silver with a possibility of copper at depth. The owner reports that these claims need a drilling program to prove them.

Attached is a map and some assay reports and a letter all of which have some reference to the claims.

Note: No price or terms was quoted by Mr. Caldwell. He is getting along in years and he would like to dispose, prove or disprove the claims. His age and finances do not permit him to work the claims. From his report it would seem that the claims are worthy of a drill hole or so, but their worth to the Hughes Tool Company would not be very great at the present time.
