DEVELOPMENT: Shallow shaft, adit.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Recent staking (9/14/84), rotary drilling.

GEOLOGY: Rock exposed in narrow, NW-trending hill is composed of unaltered, lithic-rich, biotite rhyolite welded ash-flow tuff. No obvious signs of any type of metallic mineralization.

REMARKS: Old shaft (1930-40's) sunk on cooling fractures in rhyolite, adit dump has some secondary chalcedony in vugs. Area of recent staking extends into valley to west, toward Cyanide Reservoir.
