DEVELOPMENT: Several old, shallow shafts and prospect pits.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Recent drill roads, drilling, sampling mainly to NW of old prospects.

GEOLOGY: Areas of red-stained jasperoid, some calcite and barite veining along shear zone in limestone.

Old shaft at Sample Site 1564 explores area of jasperoid, silica veining, with heavy MnO-hematite staining. No structure visible at caved shaft collar, but oxides appear to have originated in replacement pod in limestone.

Pits upslope to the NW explore pods and lenses of white crystalline barite-calcite along N40°W, 45°SW shear zone cutting grey limestone.

REMARKS: BASO claims dated 1973, notice at barite pit. Horse & Thief claims are recent (1982-83(?))
