The Hefler tungsten property consisting of the Hilltop, Hillside and Homestead 2 and 3 lode claims is situated about 3 miles southeast of Masonic, California and about 23 miles southwest of Hawthorne.

Scheelite occurs in a nearly vertical tactite zone on a granodioritelimestone contact. Quartz lenses and stringer occur with garnet which
is the dominant mineral. The mineralized tactite zone averages about
3 feet at surface, but increases to about 5 feet a short distance below
surface. From the surface pit, tactite exposures may be traced by outcrops in a south-westward direction for a distance of 300 feet; however, prospective
prospecting has been insufficient to reveal the total width or lateral
extent of mineralization. Several narrow low-grade scheelite zones

A total of 8.61 tons were mined from a surface pit and shipped to a mill at Sodaville that contained 0.55 percent WO₃.
