SYNOPSIS OF TRIP BY VICTOR E. KRAL IN NYE COUNTY JUNE 27 to JULY 2, 1949

Monday June 27. Left Sparks about 8 A.M. Stopped in Fallon to talk with Judge E. E. Winter and John Bowler.

Made a side trip to the Baxter Fluorspar and talked with W. F. Browder regarding his Ellsworth claims. While I was in the area I visited Ed Matson of the U. S. Bureau and looked over their drill sites.

Stopped and talked with Pat Willard in Gabbs.

Tuesday. Went on to Tonopah and Goldfield, stopped to see Ed Giles.

Made side trip to Montezuma district to obtain information from Jean Perry and Charles Hammock on Fairplay and Athens districts. For lack of a survey the three leasers at this property were "lost" underground therefore I made a brief Brunton-pace survey which helped them considerably.

Wednesday. Returned to Tonopah and spent balance of day in Records office. Interviewed C. C. Boak in evening.

Thursday. Spent all day in Recorder's office. In evening talked to Dan Johnson about Berlin. Talked with Charles Joseph, E. M. Booth, and Mr. Lee about San Antonio and Royston districts.

Friday. Spent morning in Recorder's office and contacted Clyde Terryll. In afternoon left Tonopah via Route 8A. Stopped at Round Mountain but Oshier had already gone home; looked around a bit and went on toward Austin. Stopped at Millett and obtained much information about the east side of the Toiyabes from "Littlehorse" Carl.

Saturday. Went into Austin and talked with Steve Linka about San Juan Canyon, Steve Deimoz and Mr. Looney about Jackson district, and Mr. Thatcher about Washington district. Left Austin early afternoon, arrived Sparks 6 P.M.
