I went to the Pappas and Schweiss properties last Friday and Saturday. I sampled the Pappas property thoroughly, with the exception of the higherade chimney which he is stoping. Several samples taken along the large vein east of the vein upon which the shaft is located all assayed less than \$1.00 in gold. I also sample the entire length of the drift on the 70 foot level in the shaft and obtained no values greater than \$1.00. other words. I think I proved that there are no values exposed on the property; with the exception of the small chute, or chimney, which he is stoping. This chimney is no doubt of very good grade, and is located at a vein crossing; that is, there is another small vein crossing the main vein at this point, which has undoubtedly made a highgrade chimney. I could find no other vein crossings on the property, and am therefore inclined to believe that this one chimney constitutes its entire virtue, and think that the property is of little interest for this reason. I found the Schweiss property of more inter-The ore zone there is somewhat indefinite and spotty, but seems to be rather large. Whether or not it is of pay grade can only be determined by rather extensive sampling. I think it would only add to the confusion to take a few samples in such a place, and would not like to determine values there without 50 to 100 samples. asked Schweiss to come in and see you when he comes: to Reno, and if you can obtain a reasonable option from him.
