The Buckhorn claims are about 29 miles north of Reno on the west slopes of the Antelope Range along the California-Nevada border. Secondary U minerals occur along narrow steeply dipping silicified fractures in Tertiary volcanic rocks of rhyolitic composition. The U minerals are in 2 zones separated stratigraphically by a thick bed of volcanic tuff. Several other U deposits have been discovered in the Tertiary volcanic rocks both north and south of the Buckhorn claims. Ore-grade material has been exposed at one deposit.
