The Alder or Tennessee Gulch District is in north central Elko County, 10 miles south of Rowland. Considerable placer mining was done in the early days, as is indicated by the old placer tailings on Gold Run Creek, half a mile north of Baker Ranch. In recent years a small amount of placer prospecting has been done in this area, but the results of this work have not been encouraging.
