GEOLOGY: Nevada Fm(Dev)? Muddy grey silty dolomite, small fault N5W, 68NE, brecciated zone 2-3 ft. N side silicified dolomite. East side dolomite. Apparent bedding plane striking NS dipping shallow to west. (No clear surface to take attitude, Cu minerals - malachite, crystalline azurite, massive brochantite coating surfaces & infilling fractures and breccia, some Fe staining, Smithsonite.

REMARKS: Site consists of cut or hole in side of outcrop, 5x5x5. With small dump on either. Another dog hole 200 ft. North in draw to south. Stone marker, no buildings or any other development.

Note: in outcrop 2" long graptolite Rhabdsome, limonite stained brown in crystalline med-grey limestone, also with corals & brachiopods silicified- Dev.?
