GEOLOGY: Area highly oxidized shear zone, country rock Vinini Fm(?) Silicious, shaley material. Light to dark grey, FeOx stained, breccia cemented with stibnite & barite. Barite crystals coating surfaces, some stibnite replacing country rock, stilbicanite, some gossan.

Site consists of 2 trenches trending N85W, approx. 25 feet long 10-15 ft. deep, small open pit area to North dozer cuts around few roads, No buildings. Not been worked in at least 25 years.
