ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Currently being Geochemed.

GEOLOGY: Limestone with breccia, cemented with calcite, veining & pockets of massive crystalline calcite limestone med grey, Fe stains on surface, area of dark olive green oxidized zone, fine sprays of galena disseminated in silicified limestone breccia, bornite, sphalerite, pyrite ghosts. Sulfides appear to be cementing areas of breccia. Devils' Gate Limestone(?) at contact with Vinini Fm with Nevada Fm in float, bedding plane N-S gently dipping E. (Roberts Mtn. thrust).

Site consists of at least 2 vertical shafts, each of at least 50 ft. deep, but probably several hundred twin ore chutes. Railing & milling stamp roads throughout area, stoped shaft trending N80E 15' deep, following breccia zone. New drill roads leading up canyon to site. Main workings appear to be following shear fault zone E-W.
