ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Shafts were sunk on 2-3 foot quartz veins bearing N20°E, 75°E. The shafts are shallow and hosted in granodiorite. Nearby prospects are on similar veins that litter the slopes. Basalt intrusives are outcropping in the north and westside of the granite.

Sample 2841 is a brecciated iron-stained quartz with possible sulfides
Sample 2842 is from the dumps near the shaft and consists of quartz
with possible Pb/Ag mineralization.
