DEVELOPMENT: Open pit(s) for barite (upper & lower pits), plus exploration trenches, drillroads, + drill pads.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, but mine recently or currently active.

GEOLOGY: Mine was visited briefly for sampling purposes only. Sample 398 was collected from a Fe & Mn stained, clay *filled*, high-angle fissure in clastic, siliceous sediments in the upper pit area. According to the county report, Silurian & Devonian sandstones & cherts are thrust juxtaposed ^{in this area}. The barite is reportedly a replacement deposit formed in several horizons of the Slaven chert.

Dozer cuts in section 23 were visited but not sampled since no mineralization other than barite was observed. The cuts were undoubtedly made for barite exploration.

REMARKS: * Name derived from owners surname (person comm. w/ Papke, 1983)

Sample 398 - Sample taken from oxidized, hydrothermal fissure which looked favorable for mineralization other than barite.
