DEVELOPMENT: A two compartment shaft reported to be 150 feet deep

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The shaft is on a north trending zone of altered tuff with a vein opened at the 55 foot level. Assays of up to \$71.55 per ton were reported when the mine operated in the 1920's. Sample 2041 was selected from the dump in propylitized, dark purple andesite tuff with minor pyrite and unidentified sulfides. Assays were not impressive except for 500ppm Sb.
