DEVELOPMENT: A shallow shaft with some short? drifts and a lower adit, possibly 100m? long  
(caved at portal).ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: The shaft near the top of the ridge explores a breccia zone in felsic crystal-vitric ash-flow tuff. It is not possible to determine the trend of this zone, although northerly or northwesterly would be a good guess. The dump here has sugary quartz vein matter on it which probably came from the shaft. The lower adit does not appear to have penetrated mineralized rock, although it is more extensive than the workings on the ridge. Possibly the lower adit was intended to intersect the mineralized zone at depth, but did not do so. Slightly propylitized andesite porphyry is seen on the dump; possibly it is from a dike.

REMARKS: Location is at end of road in Long Valley. Photo 1 of dump of lower adit. No sample.
