DEVELOPMENT: One east-striking adit.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: The adit appears to follow E-W fault zone in fractured, beige, finely crystalline limestone. Limestone is bleached, partially recrystallized & has a blocky weathering habit. Most of the rock on dump is cut by fine, white calcite veinlets, but a few samples are silicified & are cut by fine siliceous veinlets.

Sample 1621 is composed of silicified & Fe-stained limestone & limestone breccia. The sample contains some pyrite & possibly cerussite. Minor gossan was noted on dump.
