

History and production

The perlite deposits have been known for many years, but only recently has a practical use for the mineral seen been found. To date no production of perlite has been from this property.

Type Deposit (Goeolgy) Rocks in the vicinity are of volcanic origin. Three series of flows are recognized. Perlite occurs in altered areas of rhyolite. The largest outcrop is about 60 feet high, 50 feet wide and 200 feet long. Outcrops can be traced for 1,500. It is estimated that a total of 300,000 tons of perlite can be mined in this area.

Mine Workings No attempt has been made to prepare the exposed areas for mining.
