GEOLOGY: The quartz vein on which the very large incline was sunk is over 4 feet  
thick at the outcrop and was reported to be 6 feet thick at 175 feet.  
The host rock is mainly a shaley, thin plated sediment of Triassic,  
Jurassic age. Both Mr Church and his partner are treating ores from  
the dumps attempting to determine their grade as well as making general  
preparation to put the mine in production.  
Sample 2386 was sampled from the iron-stained quartz vein material  
available on the dumps.
