DEVELOPMENT: One 38 foot shaft, drill roads and pads, recently drilled

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Recently drilled

GEOLOGY: Vein in a fault contact zone between the Carrara Formation and the Mayflower Schist of Ordovician age. The shaft, which is little more than a prospect was sunk on the vein sometime in the late 1800's. Most of the dump and the workings have been destroyed by the building of roads and drill pads. Drilling was done sometime within the last year. Sample 2031 was taken from what's left of the dump and from the exposed vein, and consisted of visible tetrahedrite and other possible sulfides. Assays showed 30ppm silver, 20ppm gold with minor copper-lead-antimony.
