DEVELOPMENT: A single incline and open-stope.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: An unnamed incline and open-stope expose a vein in the bedding plane of thin bedded shale that strikes north and dips 45°E. The small workings are near the contact with a Cretaceous granite. Sample 2079 was taken from stringers in the exposed portion of the vein and from the dump. Assay values were anomalous in Ag, Cu, Pb, Sb, Zn and V.
