DEVELOPMENT: One small adit many roads, drill-pad and considerable drilling and coring.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drilling.

GEOLOGY: Drilling and sampling have revealed silver mineralization associated with veins and silicified zones in a volcanic tuff. Geochem sampling has revealed anomalous arsenic, mercury, molybdenum, antimony, spotty gold and alunite. Silication, argillization, sericitization form the major alteration products. Brecciation associated with a fine-grained pyrite in a silicified matrix was Sampled 3178 from a vein bearing N45°E 50°NW in what was later described as a hanging wall complex. Sample 3187 was from a narrow 6"-12" inch vein bearing N25°E that was reported to have been prospected by an indian. The quartz vein had visible ruby silver and other sulfides associated with a small adit in the hanging wall.
