Gentleman :

We have a quicksilver deposit that might be of interest to your concern. This ore body has tremendous possibility of developing into a great mine, as it has indicated from all previous operation and type of ore deposit.

The main ore body is a chimney or pipe 50 feet by 70 feet in diameter and it is almost vertical. The chimney ore shoot is developed only to a depth of 140 feet and continued to maintain its diameter, dip and consistency.

The ore is cinnabar in silica and the wall rock is a high density dolomite. The silica is a highly fragmentized, sandy and loose grained with cinnabar distribute throughout the ore. The ore is so free flowing that mining is simple. The ore can be drawn out at 4 draw points in haulage drift 140 feet below original surface without blasting.

About 50 feet of ore has been removed from the chimney. The remaining 10000 tons of ore in the chimney will average 6 pounds mercury per ton although assays have been as high as 24 pounds and as low as 2 pounds.

The haulage drift has been driven 300 feet in fairly solid dolomite and it encircles the ore body. In the 1930s high grade ore was taken

from a winze that went 80 feet below the haulage tunnel. ~~This winze~~

About 400 feet east of the main ore body another smaller ore shoot was explored by a 60 foot drift and a shallow winze. This ore body is 1 to 4 feet wide and running as high as 6% mercury also some native mercury has been noted. One hundred flask were taken from this shallow winze. This ore shoot dips toward the main chimney ore body. There many small high grade stringers vains leading toward the main ore body.

With all the evidence of the chimney being the main ore shoot, it must have extreme depth. This property should be explored at greater depth to prove possible a great ore body.

We are leasing this property and we have extracted some ore. Our small corporation has put a final price on this lease - \$150,000. Exploration, core drilling, options and terms can be arranged after your surface examination of the property.

The property is located 8 miles east of Beatty, Nevada by gravel road. Also, water, power and housing is available.
