GEOLOGY: Site is a 60 foot vertical shaft following a 6 inch FeO_x stained quartz vein through highly altered rhyolite tuff, (K-spars gone, chloritized), residual quartz phenocrysts, punky, limonite stained, no obvious mineralization. due north approximately 1/4 mile another 50 foot vertical shaft along shear zone between rhyolite ash tuff and highly altered rhyolite. Shear zone 2-3 feet wide dipping steeply north. Area recently drilled but no production. Rocks chloritized and mafic and K-spars gone. No observed mineralization. The two prospect pits shown on the map due north of sample site approximately .6 miles has been drilled, trenched with extensive roads put in. The new workings run through bleached, punky, highly altered rhyolite tuff. Several drill pads are across the drainage to the south. Rocks above workings highly silicious with chert and chalcedony.
