ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Workings appear on North facing ridge above Coney's Canyon and South facing ridge above Dry Canyon in the Cambrian Johnnie Formation. At Sample site 1003 Workings follow N40E 45° - 90° dipping beds, with bedding shear carrying 2-8 inch sulfide bearing bull quartz vein. Layers of gossan fill fractures inside adits. Parallel to bedding & shear planes, 1 to 10 foot wide phyllite/schist zone. Minor malachite coats quartz, euhedral calcite fill interstices of quartz vein. Quartz stockworkings appears on most outcrops. On the southern side of the ridge (sample site 1004) 400 foot adit stoped on trend of adits and prospect pits N30E and curves around to the south. Quartz veins and shear zones cut Johnnie Form along E-W trend bearing disseminated fresh and oxidized euhedral pyrite. Quartz vein highly fractured and FeOx stained. Country rock bears zones of steeply dipping (West) schist. Area dotted with shallow prospect pits.
