GEOLOGY: Situated on edge of Timber Mountain Caulders, rhyolitic ash tuffs, volcanic glass, basalt caps many of the flows and falls, abundant vertical faulting, sites sampled appear to be along cauldера rim. Sample site is 50 foot vertical shaft on east facing ridge with a second vertical shaft on top of the hill. A Sample taken from heavily FeOx stained, brecciated gouge material, in kaolinized rhyolitic ash tuff. Area has abundant slickensides, most vertical. The alteration zone at the site is approximately 100 x feet wide and appears (from the geologic map) to be along the rim of the Timber Mountain Cauldera. In contact with the alteration zone is punky, lithic and crystal rich rhyolitic ash tuff. South of the sample site is a ridge of fractured, exfoliated volcanic glass (the stuff is weathering out into sheets). North of the site, workings (which are abundant and cover several square miles in the area) appear to be following breccia zones. Area shows evidence of recent exploration and ~~Nx~~ Brian Beck, project geologist at the Oasis Project at Springdale suggests that there is a moly porphyry system at depth in the area. North of the Camp site, is a small, undeveloped ~~zeolite~~ deposit, unsampled.
