## THE TITANIC MINE

The property is owned by L.G.Sanda, and is located at the head of Iron Canyon about 12 miles west from Battle Mountain, Lander County, Nevada.

The accompanying section shows the geology of the deposit, the location of the samples taken, and the assay results obtained.

The quartzite brecciated zone is traceable for a considerable distance, and is covered by this property for about two claim lengths.

No drifting has been done on the tunnel level although the ore is soft and easily mined here. The assay returns are a little lower than the figures advanced by the owner of the mine.

The property has a fair location for mining purposes, but is not so fortunate in owning a favorable millsite. A, so there will be considerable difficulty in getting water for milling purposes.

The value of the ore - as indicated by the two samples taken - is too low-grade to warrant further consideration of the prospect at the price asked.
