A sample of 800 pounds of cobbled and picked ore was reported to assay 46.8% Sb. taken from a trench 23' long and from 6' to 10' deep.

History and production A nearby property was worked during World War I for arsenic and over the hill from this mine showing of antimony were found outcropping.

Type Deposit (Geology) A long outcrop of quartz in quartzite was prospected by trench mentioned above and 800 pounds stibnite ore cobbled and picked from the work. One place remains that shows about two pounds of stibnite along one of the walls.
