Copper Canyon Mine.

This mine has been a bright spot during the depression for leasers, shipping gold ore found to occur between two copper bearing veins.

Recently leasing has been discontinued, and Mr. R. M. Atwater, Jr., president of the company, has just returned to prosecute development work to attempt to block out sufficient milling gold ore to justify a mill. Mr. R. C. McCarthy, supt., has been working a crew of 13 men on this work.
