This old property relocated last year by "Reg" Oliver, is on a branch of Duck Creek and north of Iron Canyon. This gold quartz vein with a N 10° W and 60° dip to the east, is developed by a 150 ft. shaft and connecting tunnel, with considerable old time stoping. Recently locators shipped the tailings from the old mill site, indicating high grade ore. Mr. Oliver has established a neat camp and is now making a thorough geological study of the mine before attempting to mine possible faces of shipping ore.
