DEVELOPMENT: Two shafts one over 100 feet deep with 150 feet of drifts.  
Area to the north and west has been drilled

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Mineralization and workings along a N40W structure cut by E-W fissures  
in purple lith tuff. Silicification strong along both sets of structures is  
strong, very little alteration of host rocks locally. Area to north is cut by  
roads and drill pad sometime within the last 5 years. Sample 2100 was taken  
from dumps near the large shaft and consisted of visible copper oxides and  
sulfides and pyrite. Assay values were 500ppm Ag, 500ppm As, 300ppm MO, minor  
lead.
