DEVELOPMENT: One caved adit and several shallow shafts

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Partly caved adit, shallow shaft and pits along a knob of altered rhyolite which are silicified and argillized along fractures and shears. The adit bear S60°E and was probably connected to the shallow shaft at depth. The shaft was sunk on a northeast trending fault about 2 feet wide that is strongly oxidized and iron stained. Sample 2729 was taken from inside the adit and from the associated dump. Assay values were 3000ppm Ag, 700ppm Sb with minor Pb, and Mo.
