DEVELOPMENT: A series of old inclines shafts and prospects.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The workings are alinged along a north trending contact zone between the carbonates and the highly silicified meta-sediments. There are extensive dumps of brecciated, iron-stained vein quartz associted with the workings that extend along the ridge that over looks the camp. Very little visable mineral-ization was observed other than minor shows of copper and possible tetrahedrite Sample 2040 from the dumps and veins assayed high in antimony and lead with lessor values for silver and Copper. The veins occurr along the bedding planes and dip to the NE at 30-50°.
