GEOLOGY: Workings are on quartz veins and aplite dikes hosted in quartz monzonite. The dikes and veins are along joint sets and cooling fractures in the monzonite. Mineralization was very sparse and included pyrite, chalcopryrite and minor galena; Sample 2073. Assay values were amomalous in Bi which was greater than 1000ppm with minor copper, lead, zinc and vanadium.
