GEOLOGY: The workings are in limestone sediments of Ordovician age near the contact with porphyritic border phase of one of the plutons east of Round Mountain that have been dated as being Cretaceous in age. The selected sample 2075 was from the north trending vein and from the fault gouge that consisted of partly brecciated iron stained quartz with unidentified gray streaks of unidentified sulfides and yellow oxides. The assay values were high in arsenic, lead and zinc with lesser amounts of barium, copper, antimony and vanadium.
