DEVELOPMENT: One large shaft, prospect-pit atop a knob, open dozer-cuts on SE side
of hill. Head fram and screen erected near prospect-pit.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Workings consist of a large shaft, several shallow prospect and open-
dozer cuts hosted in thin bedded shales of Ordovician age. A number of artifacts
bearing the name Westend Consl. Mining Co, Tonopah.
Sample 2080 was taken from the large prospect pit associated with the headframe.
The thin bedded shale bears N40W, 55E. The sample was chipped from the sediment
that was deeply iron stained along its strike and seemed to be the location of
intrest at the time work was halted. Otherwise there is very little mineral-
ization that is visable.
Assay values were high in arsenic, barium, strotium, chromium and coppper with
lessor values for lead and antimony.
