DEVELOPMENT: A shallow shaft with 2 levels; 160 foot adit connects with the first level. One small cabin.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: All of the workings are in the Zabriskie quartzite of Cambrian age. The quartz vein is about 8 feet wide at the shaft and bear N60E, 70-85S. The ore vein ranged from vuggy in part to a strong silicified hydrothermal breccia that was stained a reddish-brown. Visable minerlaization included pyrite, minor copper, with some tetrahedrite (?). Assays were high in arsenic, lead and bismuth with lessor amounts of copper, antimony and zinc.
