DEVELOPMENT: Remains of old ore loading chute and rail system. Odd road, overgrown and partially covered with falling rock.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Site is lower and upper adits. Upper adit partially caved (open 2x3) with several gallons/minerals flowing from it. Several hundred feet of workings. Adit trends S75W. Lower adit (200 feet below) Mines couple feet deep.

Rocks thinly bedded, silicicicious, vertical in places highly skarned, folded in others various orientatiuous, predominantly striking NW. On dump were black platy shales and phyllites, massive white quartz vein material with shale breccia. Quartz massive to crystalline, fine grained galena, stibnite, and possibly Moly filling vugs, fractures and in pods. Also cyrstalline flecks of pyrolusite. Veining is abundant and appears to rise from West to East. Minor FeOx staining.

Lower adit caved, following vertical 1-4" quartz vein cutting sheared phyllite, minor galena.
