## History and production

Type Deposit (Goeolgy) The ore occurs as a blanket deposit of mixed manganese oxides, manganese silicate and silica in a thinly bedded shale formation. The principal constituents are silica and rhodenite with minor amounts of black manganese oxides.

Mine Workings The workings consist of several small open pits. The only pit showing ore is located on Pink Lady No. 2 claim.
