ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: At site none, however, general area had been drilled, with new roads put in, possibly within last 2 years.

GEOLOGY Old tungsten/moly workings, single shaft, approximately 50 feet, with trenching and dozing, new drill road installed, but washed out in areas, remains of old cabin, Workings in crystal rich (good collection site) epidote-garnet tactite, interspersed in skarn are oxidized and fresh masses of molybdenite and possibly huebnerite-ferberite, abundant calcite, minor dendritic pyrolusite. Area is FeOx stained and almost gossany, some boxworks, minor Cu staining. Host rock light gray, sacchroidal LS, fractured, epidotized along fractures and seams. Workings follow a N60E spine of outcropping tactite with numerous cuts and prospects pits perpendicular to ridge. Possibly Lower Cambrian Poleta Formation.
