GEOLOGY: Sample site is a small, (10X12X5) excavated solution cavity in lithic and crystal rich ash tuff (andesitic?). Principal commodity is red, green, brown, black jasper, that's banded into various patterns. The green jasper (prase) gives the appearance of jade. (Good collection site). Jasper fills cavity, fractures, and seams. Jasper outcrops throughout ridge and appears to be weathering in place. Doesn't appear to be any activity in over 5 years.

Prospect shown on the map 1 mile north of Sidewinder Claims. Dozer cut in scoria. No observed mineralization, oxidized on surface. photo, no sample.
