GEOLOGY: Two very shallow shafts explore irregular hydrothermal? breccia zones in a Tertiary quartz latite or rhyodacite intrusive. This intrusive? may cut ash-flow tuffs of similar composition. Wall rock is argillized at prospects, biotite may be converted to white mica. Narrow (2-5 mm) quartz veinlets and drusy quartz open-space fillings cut the breccia. Iron oxide minerals coat the drusy quartz. No ore minerals noted.

(2 shallow shafts, hydrothermal breccia zones in a quartz or rhyodacite intrusive. Iron-oxide covered quartz veinlets cut the breccia. No ore minerals.)
