This property comprises three claims located about one-half mile east from Duluth, in the northwestern corner of Nye County, Nevada.

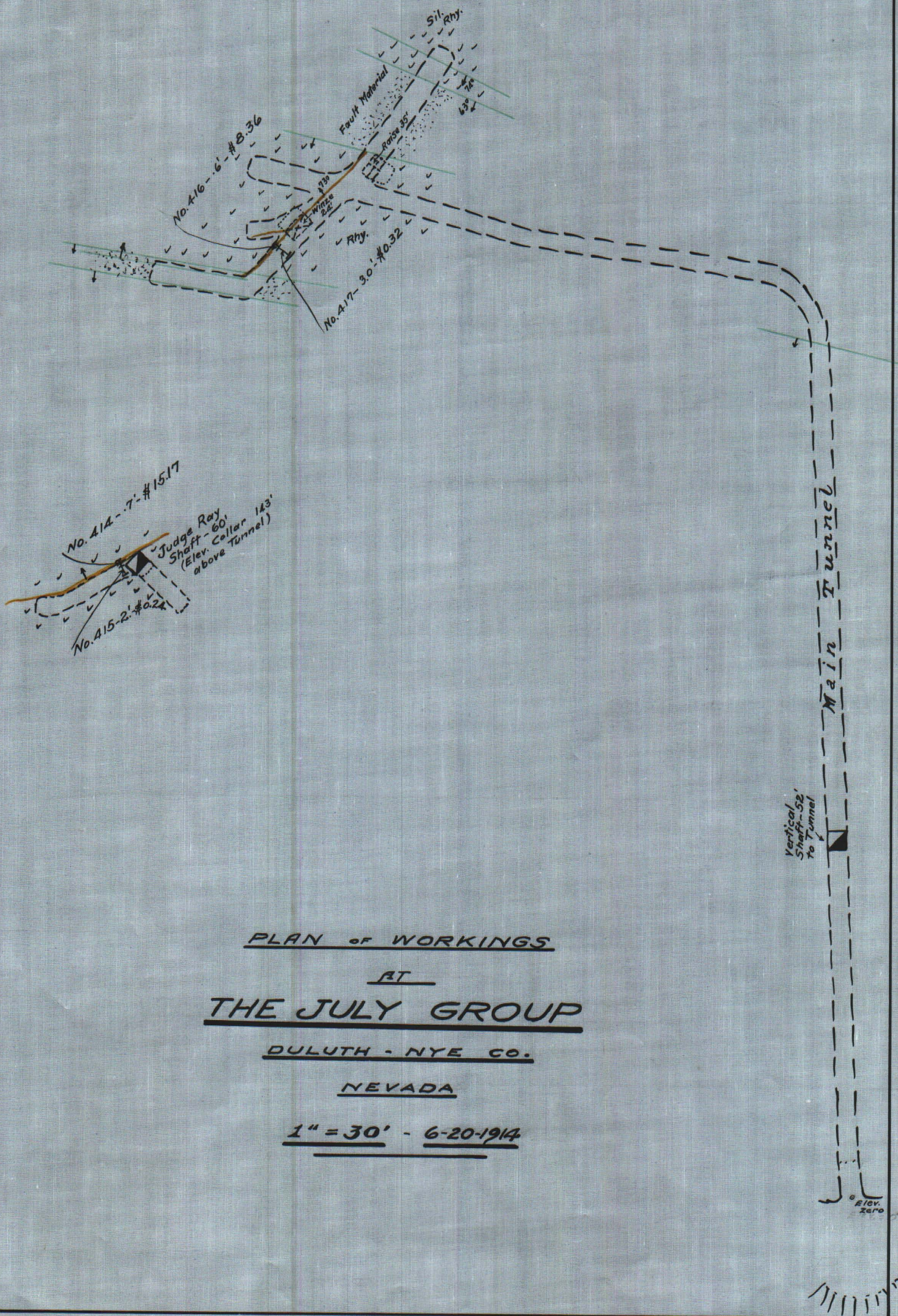
The country rock is silicified rhyolite, considerably faulted and fractured. One of these fractures is cemented by a breccia from 2" to 1' in thickness. Free gold has been deposited along this main fracture, and in some smaller branch fractures. The accompanying map shows the extent of the development work, and the location of the samples. The main fracture is cut by two strong faults so that the underground work has opened up only a segment about fifty feet in length.

Terms

The property is owned by Fife and Bills of Duluth. The total price asked is \$10,000.

Conclusions

The property is not recommended.
