DEVELOPMENT: Old workings just east of southern pit include several prospects & shafts.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Claims held by Cominco.

GEOLOGY: A very quick stop was made at the old workings east of the southern pit to sample the dump material from the shaft.

Sample 1514 was collected from the dump & consists of silicified, grey chert breccia. The breccia cement & fragments contain veinlets & clots of unoxidized pyrite. This ore is obviously from the unoxidized horizon which occurs beneath (at depth) the surface exposed oxide ore.
