PRELIMINARY REPORT ON CHAS. G. ALDRIDGE PROPERTY (FORMERLY THE WHITE LEGHORN)

NAME AND OWNER Chas. G. Aldridge, c/o V. & T. Stage, Hawthorne, Nevada.

LOCATION AND HOLDINGS (5 claims held, out of 21 originally held by White Leghorn Nining Co.) Located on Mount Grant, 7 miles off Highway, at point 16 miles north of Hawthorne, Nevada.

ACCESSIBILITY AND TRANSPORTATION Present road 2 miles up canyon from highway, but road can be extended 3 miles with little work. Last 2 miles, too steep for road, without great expense.

GEOLOGY Country rock, grano-diprite, sometimes intruded with fine grained basic rocks in small amounts. Fracture or pressure planes in grano-diorite strike northerly and dip easterly at 30 deg. to 60 deg.

VEINS OR ORE BODIES Along fissures and pressure planes that strike slightly east of North and dip east. Outcrops irregular and mineralization carrying copper and silver usually (but sometimes lead as well as low values in gold) seem too spotted to develop into any size with depth.

SAMPIES AND ASSAYS There is no ore showing, excepting small isolated bunches and they represented no tonnage, so I took no samples.

DEVELOPMENT One lower tunnel on south end of property has about 900 ft. of drifts and crosscuts at probably an average of \$15.00 per foot. Two upper middle tunnels (probably on a different vein from above) have 300 and 100 ft. respectively, and the former has a 50 ft. winze that cost \$5000.00. Spots of tetrahedrite carrying high silver at top of winze disappeared before the bottom was reached. One tunnel on north end of property about 300 or 400 ft.
